Animals with Acrylic & Metallic Leaf – Jean Bradbury

Student Supplies:

A wooden or Masonite panel (not a canvas), cradled or not. Should measure about 9x12 or 12x18 inches

Acrylic paint in a selection of colours. (prefer Golden fluid acrylics. One blue, one red, one yellow, one black, one white, one brown such as raw umber)

A selection of brushes should include some small “rounds” for painting thin lines. Numbers 1-4 are good. A “rigger” is fun and suggested but can be shared if you don’t own one.

Photographs of animals you may want to paint. The better the photos the more you will have to work with. Full body or head shots are fine. Bring several to choose from. (tip – get down on the floor to photograph your pet at her own level). *Please be in touch with Jean before coming to MISSA to be sure you have appropriate photos.*

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
