LETTING IT GO: Abstract Painting – Eunmi Conacher

Student Supplies:

Reference: Bring 1 or 2 of your favourite magazines. (e.g. National Geographic) or (Home Furnishings).

Painting surfaces: for 2 or 3 small and 1-2 large paintings.

For beginning exercises use watercolour paper or small canvas or wood panel or canvas board.

Suggested sizes: a mix of sizes - 5X7, 6X6, 12X12, 11X14, 24X24, or 30X40.

1 or 2 old paintings you can paint over (OPTIONAL)

Painting equipment:

easel – MISSA has tables to set up table easels.

Scissors & masking tape

Paper towels or rags

Containers for water

Apron

Sharpies or pencil

Medium: small jar HEAVY (High Solid) Gel Gloss for creating texture in acrylics.

Paint: Oils or ACRYLICS - I use artist grade acrylics in mix of viscosities - liquid (I like Golden) and tube (Liquitex, Golden). Bring your preferred colours - artist grade

My ACRYLIC palette: titanium white, cad yellow deep or Indian yellow hue, cad red light or cad red medium, dioxazine purple, cobalt blue, pthalo blue, Liquitex - Light Blue Permanent, Light Blue Violet, Cobalt Teal, Quinacridone Magenta, Quinacridone Nickel Azo Gold, Nickel Azo Yellow, Black & White house paint.

Optional colours: yellow ochre, ultramarine blue, burnt umber, Ivory black, Transparent Red Iron Oxide, student grade basic yellow deep and basic red, oil pastel. If you do not have some of these, bring what you have.

White Gesso: Liquitex Super Heavy Gesso, or Stevenson Heavy Gesso

Black Gesso: (small container)

Brushes: Bring what you like to use – at least 1 small, 1 medium, 1 large (at least 2 inch).

Students working in oils must bring low-odor materials.

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
