HANDMADE PAPER – Dorothy Field

Student Supplies:

I will provide several sheets of different types of handmade paper for each student. You can bring any other papers you like, even small scraps can be useful – almost any kind of paper. I often like the effect of thinner rather than thicker papers— you might think about old love letters, laundry lists, spirit papers from Chinatown, translucent papers, Japanese lace papers, etc, etc

- soft gel semi gloss – small container
- Small sheet of plexiglass and pencil for lift printing
- Ink roller if you have one
- One tube of water soluble printing ink (speedball blockprinting ink or Charbonnel Aqua Wash), colour of your choice, the class can share different colours. A small container will be fine.
- Large cheap brush for starch
- One or two lousy brushes for mixing pigment, etc.
- Spoon for burnishing paper
- Dust mask
- Self-healing board if you have one
- Mat knife
- Whatever basic art supplies you like to use: pens, pencils, pastels, powdered graphite, graphite sticks, etc.
- bone folder if you have one
- Hair dryer (don't buy one – we'll have enough to share)
- A few tops from yogurt containers for mixing pigments
- If you have books that you find inspirational, please feel free to bring them for others to look at
- Apron
- Notebook/sketchbook
- Ruler
- Writing materials

In general don't buy a whole lot of stuff you may not use again. I'll bring stuff and the class will share. It always works out fine. If you are shopping in Victoria, Island Blue gives students a 10% discount. Opus will not charge students PST. You may need to bring something to prove you are a student.

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
