SURFACE DESIGN & BLOCK PRINTING – Mo Hamilton

Student Supplies:

- Five small paint trim rollers to be used as brayers
- 4 yards of prewashed good quality cotton muslin cut in a manageable size of 20” by 20”
- 2 yards of plain colored fabric with no texture either cotton, linen, canvas (optional)
- Fabric scraps for testing your prints
- (optional) fabric that you may have already such as linen, broadcloth, twill mostly natural fiber and with not too much texture
- Two pieces of either glass/plexiglass , minimum 8”x10” size. If you have more, please bring them.
- 10 pieces of soft carve lino, 3”x4” each
- Lino carving tool with multiple blades
- Quilting ruler (optional)
- Pencils, erasers, 10 pieces of white computer paper, 4 pieces of cardstock 8.5”x11”
- 1 yard of no-texture fleece.
- Fabric scissors
- 2 jars of black and white silkscreen for fabric ink and 1 each of yellow, blue and red (make sure it is for fabric!)
- 1 tube of fabric medium for acrylic paint and whatever acrylic paint you happen to have on hand. (optional)
- Rags and/or cloths for clean-up
- White artist’s apron
- Images, ideas and drawings for your block-prints.
- Journal for taking notes
- Wooden tongue depressors for scooping out ink.

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
