ECO-PRINTING – Kathy Johnson

Student Supplies:

- Small notebook for note taking
- Scissors
- 24" long metal ruler
- Brown or Black fine point marker that is not water soluble (Micron or Sharpie brands are good)
- Pencil
- 11"x14" pad of inexpensive watercolour paper (does not need to be Strathmore. Canson or other brand is fine) approx. 20 pages, 140# (300g) cold or hot press (Spiral bound preferred but not crucial)
- 2 yards of 45" lightweight white or cream cotton muslin fabric
- Disposable dust and filter facemask
- 2-3 Embroidery needles, size #5
- 2-3 Crewel needles, size #2
- 10 small safety pins - for attaching name tags to your bundles for Identification
- Tyvek envelope – approx. 6"x9" - will be cut up to make name tags for bundle identification
- awl for punching holes in paper (for hand stitching purposes)
- 1" flat bristle or foam brush (inexpensive – will be used with acrylic medium)
- 8" x 10" (approx.) piece of scrap corrugated cardboard
- 8 - Extra Large Binder Clips 2-Inch (not bull clips)
- 4 - 5" x 7" pieces of 1/8" Hardboard, must be shiny on both sides
- Dowel – 10" long, 1" diameter
- 4 small towels - tea towel size is good
- Apron to protect clothing from dye and rust stains
- Wear clothing & footwear you don't mind getting stained

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE OPTIONAL:

- plant material: tree leaves, shrub leaves, weeds, flowers can be or miss but are always worth trying. Nothing that is very fleshy (ie succulents) or anything toxic.
- Piece of light coloured 100% wool - Can be as small as 10" x 10" (thrift stores are a great source for finding wool coats, blankets, and sweaters you can cut up)
- White or light colored silk scarves - again, check out those thrift stores :)
- Book pages - from an old garden book (Will be cut to or folded to 5x7)
- Onion skins - from Red and/or Yellow (about a handful or so)
- Random small pieces of flat rusty metal - washers, finishing nails (for adding to bundles when steaming & boiling)

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
