Student Supplies:

Wet wipes (baby wipes)

Plastic containers to carry unbaked clay (any plastic container that's NOT clear plastic, like candy boxes).

The plastics with the following recycling numbers are SAFE:

- #1 – PET or PETE Polyethylene Terephthalate
- #2 – HDPE High Density Polyethylene
- #4 – LDPE Low Density Polyethylene
- #5 – PP Polypropylene

The plastics with the following recycling numbers are NOT SAFE:

- #3 – PVC Poly Vinyl Chloride
- #6 – PS and EPS Poly Styrene and Expanded Poly Styrene

Plastic sleeves (for storing clay veneers for future use)

Acrylic Roller (available for purchase from the instructor if you don't have one at \$6)

Optional:

Pasta maker (can be purchased at second hand shops, etc), very helpful in blending clays together.

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
