Student Supplies:

- Clay – 25-50 pounds cone 6 stoneware suitable for handbuilding
- General assortment of hand building tools
- Shimpo Banding wheel, short style, width not as important (please bring one if you have one)
- Sponge
- Needle tool
- Cut off wire
- Ribs, metal and plastic
- MudTool - Sherrill rib (Polymer Shape 4, medium hardness, Green with a sharp corner)
- Exacto knife
- Carving tools
- Wood Knife (see right)
- Cheese cutter- flat as possible - no bubble handles
- INSTRUCTOR WILL HAVE FOR SALE
 - Wood Knife - \$15 USD
 - Cheese Cutter - \$15 USD
 - Sunshine Stick - \$25 USD
- Paddle, if you have one (optional)
- Rolling pin & slats (for slabs)
- Craft paper for template making
- Canvas or other work surface
- Ware boards
- Plastic for covering work
- Felt pen
- Sponges and buckets for clean-up
- Old hand-towels
