Weekend One: July 30-31

Urban Sketching with Ink & Watercolour PETER LOEBEL

Supplies to Bring:

- Graphite Pencil HB or B and an eraser like Staedler Mars Plastic or similar
- Waterproof Black Ink Pen (like Uni-ball Vision Fine or similar)
- A good quality watercolour set, not more than 16 colours. It's better to have fewer colours but larger (full) pans. Include the following colours:
 - Burnt Siena
 - Raw Siena or Yellow Ochre
 - A warm and cold version of each primary colour. For example:
 - New Gamboge and Lemon Yellow
 - Cadmium red light and Alizarin Crimson (Cadmium is expensive, so you can chose an alternative.)
 - Ultramarine Blue and Phthalo Blue (green shade).
- **Watercolour Brushes:** 2-3 good quality brushes, not too small, I suggest Round #8 and #12 plus a larger mop brush to lay a wash. I would rather you buy a single quality brush like the Escoda Versatil (size 14) than a set of 10 mediocre tiny brushes.
- **Watercolour Paper:** Cotton Watercolour block (max. 11x14) or at least 10 quarter sheets (11 x 15 inch. If you don't have a sturdy block, you might want to get a slightly larger than paper-size Masonite board (or similar) on which you can tape the watercolour sheets on.
- Small water spray bottle and paper towels.
- A number of 8.5 x 11 inch sketch sheets or a cheap smaller sketch block to record your composition ideas.
- Masking tape, preferably white, I suggest 1.5 inch wide

- A number of suitable photos to sketch from. Think about good contrast, “good” composition and colours.
- A stool or lightweight chair to sit on (we will be sketching a few hours outdoors, weather permitting)

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
