Student Supplies:

Clay: 1-2 boxes (44-88 lbs) of throwing clay. Cone 10 stoneware preferred, such as H440, H550, Laguna B-mix or similar.

Note that work will not be fired, so if your preferred throwing clay is cone 6, please bring that.

Batts: 5-8 10" batts, Battmate, batt pins for fastening batts to wheel

Pottery tools:

- toggle wire
- sponges
- bucket
- apron
- towel
- small mirror
- chamois
- pin tool
- bulls tongue *(see below)
- selection of ribs (silicone, wood, metal, rubber) cheese slicer or yumi
- wooden stick or bamboo knife
- knives (fettling, paring, exacto)
- serrated rib
- nylon brush
- Sherrill shredder
- metal trimming tools (various)
- rubber and wood modelling tools
- dressmakers measuring tape
- ruler
- calipers
- bamboo brushes of various sizes
- scissors
- small decorative stamps
- cheesecloth and light plastic
- lidded plastic tub and packing if you plan to transport work home

***bull's tongue** is a specialty tool available from most pottery supply stores. If you do not have one, it is critical to my bowl making process, and I strongly suggest acquiring one



Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
