Mark Making with Handmade Brushes & Tools

Student Supply List:

MAIN SUPPLIES:

- A selection of paper - watercolour paper, rice paper, mulberry paper or any other paper that is recommended for use with wet media such as ink. (Note: some watercolour and rice paper will be provided)
- Black India ink (waterproof is preferable) plus any other ink you would like to experiment with such as coloured acrylic inks (Note: some will be provided).

TOOLS/EQUIPMENT: (some supplies will be available)

- Garden clippers, garden gloves, masking or artists tape approx. 1" wide, glue, scissors, Exacto knife, latex or vinyl gloves for art making.
- Binding materials such as string, jute, leather strips, wool, wire, fabric strips etc. to hold your brushes together.

OPTIONAL items to bring:

- Any decorative items such as beads, feathers, dried flowers etc. to adorn your brushes.

INSTRUCTOR COMMENTS:

- Our goal is to create an original art making tool that is one-of-a-kind, and says something about you and your artistic sensibility. To that end, it can be made of any natural materials that speak to you.
