Introduction to Mokuhanga: Japanese Woodblock Printmaking

MAIN SUPPLIES:

- Paper for sketching and proofing, 8.5x11 inches or larger, (10 or more sheets).
- Sharpie with narrow tip, permanent.
- HB and 2/4B pencil
- Pencil sharpener and eraser
- 2 transparency sheets, approx. 8.5x11 inches
- 2 pieces of wax paper, approx. 10x10 inches each.
- 1 piece of nonslip mat approx. 12x10 inches.
(the type for kitchen drawers works well)
- 4 small mixing brushes for inks
- 2 medium to small stencil brushes

TOOLS:

- Carving tools: 1 small gouge and 1 large gouge
- 1 knife tool (flat blade, but angled)
- Baren-block printing tool

OPTIONAL items to bring:

- Gouache, if you already own some
