### **PAINT**

Quin Burnt Orange (Daniel Smith) or Burnt Sienna (Winsor Newton)

Cobalt Blue

Phthalo Blue GS, French Ultramarine Blue, Paynes Grey (WN)

Permanent Rose (WN)

Permanent Alizarin Crimson

DS Quin Coral, Mineral Violet (Holbein)

Nova Gamboge (Holbein), or Gamboge in (van Gogh or Opus brand)

Yellow Ochre

Quin Gold (DSmith, or WN)

Green Gold

Cobalt Turquoise Light

Viridian

**Palette.** Any palette is fine as long as it has large mixing areas. Add white china plates if it doesn't (No plastic plates)

**Paper: The paper makes a huge difference to the end result.**

\*Arches 140lb cold press paper. I recommend purchasing 1 sheet (22x30 inches) as it is the most economical way to buy it and best quality. The quality differs in pads and blocks. However, if you have a block that is okay. No Student Quality papers. No Opus brand paper.

The painting can be 12"x16" and up to 13"x18". To fit on a 16"x20" board when taped



## Brushes:

Bring what you have or at least a #20 **or** #18, #16 and #12, #10 round brush. I use Black Velvet series from The Silver Brush Co. I do have some available for purchase.

- Water bucket, cellulose sponge or cotton towel for blotting brush
- Board to tape paper to. (Available at MISSA. Please ask).
- Tape cream coloured 2" wide.
- Masking Fluid, I use Pebeo drawing gum. I will have brushes to use with the Masking fluid.
- Rubber cement pick up.
