MAIN SUPPLIES:

- apron/work clothes
- sketchbook
- drawing tools (pens, pencils, markers etc. materials you enjoy drawing with)
- sandpaper (1 sheet each of 120,180 & 220 grit)
- wire cutters
- small pliers

- specialty papers (for decorative finish)
- acrylic paints and brushes (colours and brush sizes for finishing surface)
- "found objects" you may wish to incorporate into your sculpture
- small pieces of light weight fabric (old silk patterned ties or fine scarves can work well!)
