Student Supply List

FABRIC:

- One used tablecloth or small-table-sized piece of fabric that you have shared food on before the start of class.
- Scrap light coloured fabric for learning stitches (approximately 2 square feet)
- Printed fabrics you have connection to (see special comments below).
- Copy of a recipe you would be willing to share a memory about
- Variety of coloured embroidery cottons in (6-10)

TOOLS/EQUIPMENT:

- Small fabric scissors (blade around 4")
- 3-5 embroidery needles with a variety of eye sizes (small enough to fit sewing thread through to large enough to fit a full strand of embroidery cotton)
- embroidery hoop (between 6" 10" in diameter)

OPTIONAL items to bring:

- Disappearing ink pen for fabric
- sewing pins
- needle threader

INSTRUCTOR COMMENTS:

• The printed fabric can be from clothes you love, other kitchen linens, etc. These will be sewn on to your 'tablecloth' using applique techniques.
