Student Supply List

MAIN SUPPLIES:

- Construction paper pad (this is the inexpensive kind that kids use, can be bought at Dollar Store or any drugstore)
- **Coloured cardstock** package, 8.5 x 11" (the best place to buy this is at a Michaels store, they have a brand called "Recollections" and you can get 200 beautiful coloured sheets for \$20)
- Glue sticks -buy a package of 12 (.29 oz), UHU brand permanent (I usually buy these on Amazon.ca but you can purchase them at most stationary stores). Other brands work as long as they have the word "permanent" on them. I have specified the small size of glue sticks as we are working on a small scale (do not confuse "glue sticks" with the glue used for a glue gun).
- Scissors (ideally a small pair of craft or embroidery scissors and a larger pair)
- **Vogue Magazine** (I have specified Vogue because it has the best variety of colours and patterns -if you can't find a copy of Vogue where you live, look for any other fashion magazine as clothes make excellent material for collage landscapes.
- **Gardening magazines**, seed or bulb catalogues or secondhand books with flower or plant images (to be cut up for collage). A good place to find these are used bookstores or thrift shops. If you cannot find any of these don't worry, I will bring extras that you can use.

Optional

- X-acto knife (No. 11 blade) and spare blades
- Self-healing cutting mat

Instructor comments:

Most of the work in the workshop will involve cutting with small scissors but some people prefer using X-acto knives for fine details (this is more of a personal preference option). You can also use X-acto knives on the back of a magazine (not necessary to have a cutting mat).
