## Student Supply List

Clay:
The best choice is a sculpture clay with grog in it - this helps reduce slumping when building taller work.

- Plainsman M332G (a red clay with $15 \%$ grog) OR
- Plainsman MSculp (buff coloured, heavily grogged)

Hand building tools:
These can be the standard wooden tools sold for clay sculpture as well as a fettling knife and wire clay cutter. Some smaller metal tools are helpful for detail work - these are dental tools sold in art supply stores (or at Princess Auto).

- Wooden skewers to support work. Ribs of various sizes and flexibility.

Other needed items:

- 24 " $\times 24$ " board (drywall* or plywood) *Can be bought through MISSA if travelling
- Apron
- sponges and rags
- clay tools

OPTIONAL items to bring:

- Sketchbook, pencils

NOTE: Clay can be ordered ahead and delivered to MISSA. Details to follow.
