Student Supply List

CLAY POTS:

- 6 pieces of pottery greenware in light or white bodied clay. Your choice of small to medium sized: bowls, cylinders, mugs, plates etc.

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

- Bring any underglazes and/or underglaze pencils, pastels that you already have
- A liner brush (called a rigger)
- Finesline applicator bottle
- Soft paintbrushes of various widths (up to 1.5" wide) and shapes - bring what you have and if purchasing, choose watercolour brushes
- Palette - white plastic plate, tile, or piece of plexiglass
- Sketchbook - 8x11 or larger
- Old magazines (2-4)
- Scissors, glue stick, pencil
- Print out 5 or 6 of your favourite photos (nature, landscapes, flowers etc.) on full sheet of computer paper

TOOLS/EQUIPMENT:

- Sgraffito tools - needle tool, fork, serrated rib, comb etc.
- Water container - ice cream bucket or yogurt container

OPTIONAL items to bring:

- Banding wheel - please bring only if you have one
- If you are traveling by plane, bisque fired pots are an option to bring

SPECIAL INSTRUCTOR COMMENTS:

- There is an option of ordering the underglazes from Vancouver Island Pottery Supply and having them delivered to MISSA.
- If you are purchasing underglazes, I recommend (4 oz containers) Spectrum 511 (Aztec Brown) 523 (Honey) 525 (Lime Green) 532 (Sky Blue) 536 (Bright Blue) and Amaco V361 2oz. (Jet Black)
