## Student Supply List

Paint - You can bring the colours you usually use but please make sure to include at least the following 8 colours: (less expensive colours of a Cadmium hue are fine but pay attention to whether they are light or deep)

- Titanium white
- Permanent or Alizarin crimson
- Ultramarine blue
- Cadmium orange*
- Cerulean or Turquoise blue
- Burnt umber
- Cadmium yellow light*
- Naples yellow

Brushes - Most types of bristle brushes are fine. You can use the brushes you usually use but I recommend including the following:

- 1 flat \#10 or \#12 (approx. 1-1½ inches wide)
- 2 flat or filbert \#3 or \#4
- 1 round \#1 or \#2
- 1 large flat house painting type brush 2-3 inches wide.


## Palette for oils

- I recommend disposable palette sheets


## Palette for acrylics

- I recommend you try a stay-wet palette (buy the largest) OR disposable sheets


## Medium for oils

- Small bottle of linseed oil
- Odourless mineral spirits (ie: Gamsol) NO SUBSTITUTES
- 1 small empty glass jars with lid
- 1 small container for your medium; can be bought at an art store, or use a clean tuna can or baby food jar.

Medium for acrylics - Acrylic medium of your choice for acrylics

## Paper

We will be doing some studies/exercises on paper. Get a larger format (at least 11" x 14 ") you can always cut a larger size down or in half but too small is frustrating and unproductive. A pad is economical and nice to have.

- For oils, you must either have canvas paper or paper that you have pre-gessoed or Arches for oils
- For acrylics, any paper that can withstand wet media is fine but gessoed or canvas paper won't wrinkle, drink paint and has a more interesting texture.


## Canvas and Board

- In addition to studies and exercises we will work on more "finished" projects. You can work on canvas or board whenever you want but bring at least 3 so that you have options.

Additional supplies you will need

- A couple small plastic container (like yoghurt) for water
- Palette knife (teardrop shaped)
- Masking tape
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Paper towels (blue shop towels are excellent)


## Clothing

Bring comfortable "painting" clothes or an apron. (MISSA sells great aprons!)
