## Student Supply List

**Embroidery Floss** – DMC Skeins (6 stranded Embroidery Floss)

- **COLOURS:** A variety of each students' own decisions about skin tones but based on something that would read as a **deep tone:** brownish or deep bluish, **medium tone:** sand, tan or blues or greens, **pale tone:** such as beiges or other pinks, pale blues, pale lavender plus reds, red/oranges or maroons. One about 1-2 skeins of each colour is needed. We will be sharing and the instructor will be bringing floss too.
- **COLOURS:** black, grey, white (bring your own skeins of these and we will share)

**Embroidery Needles:** Based on what you can easily thread. *Try some out beforehand.*

**Fabric:** Cotton Canvas unbleached about 10 Oz. unwashed, or cotton muslin, unbleached, unwashed or linen medium weight. Bring about ½ meter and we can share. Do not wash beforehand.

Other supplies:

- Small, pointed embroidery scissors (essential!)
- Small snack-sized zip lock type bags for separated threads or 'threads-in-use'
- Drawing pencils: 2B X 2, small sharpener
- Sketchbook: any size - doesn't have to be new, we need 10 pages for studies and sketches

OPTIONAL Items to bring:

- Thimble, optional but very useful for 5 days of stitching
- Embroidery hoop: Medium sized – not too small or too large) too small and you cannot manipulate easily, too large and becomes awkward to hold into yourself for close study work.
- Carbon or graphite or other craft transfer paper- if you have some bring it, the instructor will have some available
- Iron / ironing board – *only if you are local.* MISSA will have one set up.
- Fabric eraser – Instructor will provide
