Student Supplies

MAIN SUPPLIES

- WORDS to a favorite song or a poem or a haiku or a quotation. Ten to fifteen words are fine.
- Three inexpensive clean house painting bristle brushes, 2 or three inches wide. You can usually buy them at a hardware store.
- Two clean large jars, e.g., pickle jars with a wide enough opening to get the brush in or two large plastic yoghurt containers.
- 1 oz. bottles of FLUID Acrylics in three colors to create good mixes for your painted journal. Opus has a house brand which is the most reasonably priced. Email Lorraine if you would like suggestions for possible colours. Try to think of colors which “go” with your chosen words.
- Recycle a small spray bottle to use with water, e.g., the size of eyeglass cleaner bottle 125mL
- Scissors – any size
- HB Pencil/white eraser/pencil sharpener
- Metal edge ruler, 12 inches or more
- Number 11 Exacto knife and a few replacement blades OR an OLFA cutter with a few blades.
- Scrap paper to glue on like an old magazine with glossy paper.
- Two new 40 g. glue sticks– UHU is a good brand.
- A surface to cut on like a 12 by 18 inch piece of matt board or a resealable cutting matt
- Bone Folder
- Collage papers - thin papers like Japanese washi or rice paper, printed papers, Chinese prayer paper. I will bring my box of collage papers to share.
- Box of colour pencils (at least 8) and/or watercolour pencils
- Small pointed watercolor brush e.g., Size 3 or 4
- Black rollerball pen or any other brand of fine line pens. Bring a few sizes if you have.

OPTIONAL items to bring:

- Caran d'ache watersoluble crayons
- Posca pens
- Small package of baby wipes is very handy

SPECIAL COMMENTS

- Wear old clothing or use an apron for painting

All students are responsible for bringing supplies to class. Any material fees charged are in addition to these supplies.

Please bring packing materials to safely transport your work home.
